How many birds make Camp Riversite their home? Which ones migrate? We’ll be making a fun bird feeder and having a snack! Bring a lawn chair

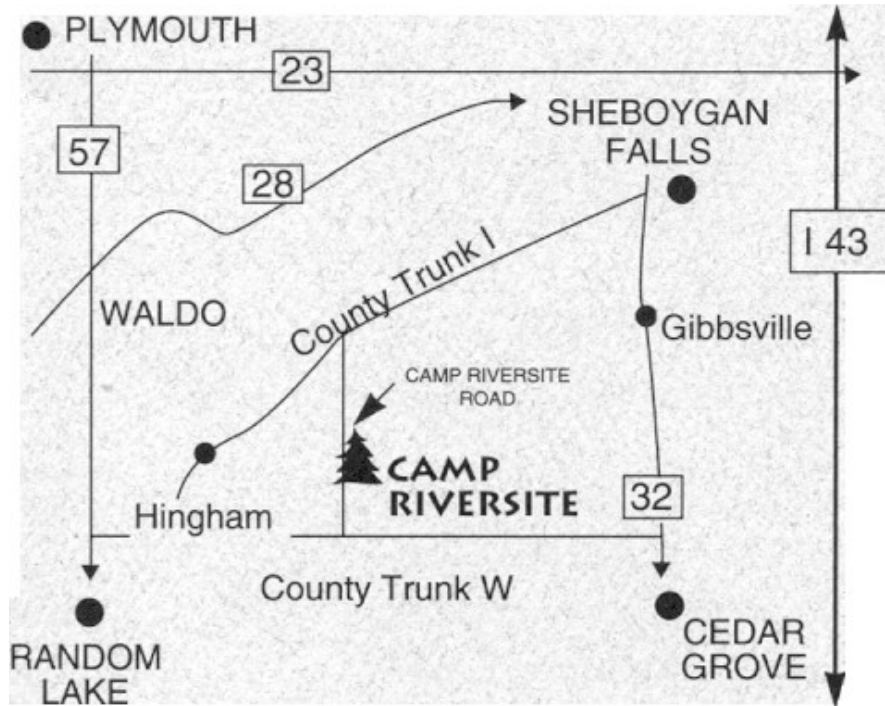


September Pine View Wildlife Rehabilitation (date and time tbd)
