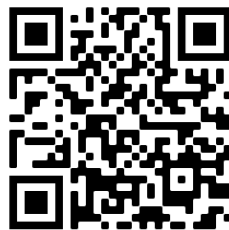

A TYPICAL DAY OF CAMP



Each day of camp provides a variety of safe and fun adventures!

8:15AM - 8:30AM - CHECK-IN YOUR CAMPER

8:30AM - OPENING CEREMONY

Each morning we meet with our counselors, raise the flag and get excited for the day ahead!

8:45AM - ICE BREAKERS

Each day we have ice breakers and games to get to know the other campers and make friends.

CAMP DAY: 9:00AM - 3:30PM

Campers begin their adventure with a wide variety of small and large group activities, nature activities, arts & crafts, water fun, games, sports, special themed activities and more while growing as individuals! Mornings are so busy that we can't help but build up an appetite. Mid-day we'll kick back and relax by eating lunch and making new friendships out at the campsite.

Water fun begins after lunch with a jump in the swimming pool, swimming at the lake or enjoying a variety of water activities such as our slip n' slide, tubing in the river and much more! To end our day, campers will enjoy a snack and one last activity.

3:45PM - CLOSING CEREMONY

We round out our day with a closing ceremony: lowering the flag, a camp song and end of day reminders.

4:00PM - CHECK-OUT & DEPARTURE

Each afternoon we say goodbye to our counselors and friends as we get picked up or head to the bus to go home and share our exciting camp day!

PLEASE READ: Throughout the week campers participate in an all-camp games. Campers choose their own activity on selected days of the week. Specialty camps may take off-site trips or require more time for instruction so the activity period in the morning may be longer. The rest of the daily schedule is adjusted accordingly.

CAMP POOL

All groups using our pool are supervised by camp staff who are lifeguard certified by the American Red Cross. Each camper is required to take a swim test to determine their swimming ability. If your child passes the swim test, they will wear a green wristband. If they do not pass, they are required to stay in the roped-off shallow end. The deepest part of our pool is 4 ½ feet and the shallowest area is 2 ½ feet. Lifejackets are available to use upon request. More pool information can be found in the Parent Handbook.

CAMP STORE

The camp store is your official source for a wide variety of novelty items and camp "swag" such as t-shirt's, sweatpants, long sleeve sweatshirts, hats and more! Campers may also purchase nutritious snacks and refreshments on only Tuesday & Thursday of each camp week. The store is also open during the Thursday Family Program. The store is not open on Monday & Friday. Snack items are \$0.25 to \$1.50. Merchandise items range from \$1.50 to \$50.00. We recommend purchasing all merchandise items on Thursday night.

PLEASE READ: If your child is registered for Maywood Camps, Maywood Campers do not have the option to visit store. Families are welcome to visit Camp Y-Koda to purchase items from the store.

PLEASE READ: Please label your child's name on everything they bring to camp. If any other supplies are needed, camp will inform you. Camp Y-Koda and the YMCA is not responsible for any misplaced, stolen or lost items at camp. All lost & found items at camp are held for two weeks, and will be discarded soon after. Our lost & found collection is available to view during our weekly Thursday Parent Program.

PLEASE DO NOT BRING

Our camp encourages children and teens to learn and play in nature, and we strongly believe in the importance of less distractions during our camp program. These items are not to be brought to camp each day. If brought to camp, these items will be taken away and kept in the office until a parent comes to pick them up. They will not be returned to the child at the end of the day.

CAMP T-SHIRT

A camp t-shirt is included in the registration fee. Campers receive their t-shirt at the beginning of their first camp week. They receive only one t-shirt, regardless of how many weeks of camp they attend.



LUNCH & COOKOUT

Campers must bring a bag lunch with them to camp Monday - Thursday unless otherwise specified. Camp provides lunch only on Fridays as all campers participate in an authentic campfire cookout. Milk is provided every day with lunch as well as a nutritious afternoon snack. All meals are provided for off-site adventure trips and resident camps.



ELECTRONICS AND CELL PHONE POLICY

Cell phones and other electronic devices are NOT permitted at Camp Y-Koda or Maywood. Our programs promote the opportunity for participants to learn and play in nature and we strongly believe in the importance of disconnecting during the camp experience. Please leave them at home. **If brought to camp, these devices will be taken away and kept in the office until a parent comes to pick them up.** They will not be returned to the child at the end of the day.

TRANSPORTATION

There is a \$15.00 per week fee for those who use the bus service as part of their summer camp experience. Please indicate which stop your camper will use on page 15 of the registration form.

Changes in transportation must be made in writing. Phone calls are not accepted. You may send a note with your child or email to camp.

Buses run every week with several pick-up and drop-off points throughout Sheboygan, Kohler and Sheboygan Falls. A camp staff member is assigned to each bus as a monitor.

EXTENDED CARE

Camp Y-Koda offers before and after camp care at the Sheboygan YMCA, Sheboygan Falls YMCA and Camp Y-Koda. Below are the times and locations that are available. YMCA staff will not be available before 7:15am. A late pick-up fee of \$5.00 per 15 minutes after 5:30pm will be charged.

The fee for extended care is \$25.00 per week. Pre-registration is required; please mark the appropriate box on your registration form. If you do not sign up for extended care, you are expected to be at the designated bus or camp location to pick up your child.

PLEASE READ: Extended care is not available at Maywood. Campers who need extended care should sign up for bussing and extended care at the Sheboygan YMCA.

Sleepover, Night Activities & S'mores!

THURSDAY NIGHT FAMILY PROGRAM - ONLY AT CAMP Y-KODA

On Thursdays, campers leave at 4:00pm and then return later with their family for the Thursday Family Program. During the week, groups prepare songs and skits to perform at the program. This event allows families to meet the counselors, tour the grounds and see the activities the camper has been doing all week. The program begins at 7:30pm for weeks 1-7 and at 7:00pm for weeks 8-11. Families are encouraged to arrive 30 minutes prior to drop items off and shop at the camp store. When the program is finished, we offer an optional authentic camp sleepover for campers. Please see below for more information on the sleepover. When the program is finished, all campers not sleeping over can go home with their families and return to camp on Friday. The Family program and sleepover will be held rain or shine.

If the Family Program & sleep over is cancelled due to inclement weather, it will be announced on our website www.sheboygancountyyymca.org/camp-y-koda and Facebook page.

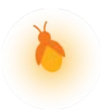
THURSDAY CAMP SLEEPOVER - ONLY AT CAMP Y-KODA

Although the sleepover is optional, camp strongly recommends having your camper sleepover for the authentic camp experience and continue learning life skills. Campers will sleep in our cabins or lodges, and partake in night activities and have a campfire to roast s'mores.

After the family program is finished, parents are to walk their child to their counselor. If campers have medication to take during their time at camp, medication must be turned into the camp director and sign the required form. Medication must be in the original container. For more information on medication, please read the Parent Handbook.

PLEASE READ: If your child is registered for a Pee Wee Camp, Pee Wees do not have the option to sleepover. Bedtime snacks & breakfast is served to all campers who attend the sleepover.

MAYWOOD CAMPS: If your child is registered for Maywood Camps, campers do not have the option to sleep over at Maywood. Campers do not have the option to join Camp Y-Koda sleepovers unless they are registered for a Camp Y-Koda camp.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

FIRST DAY TO REGISTER

Registration will begin on Tuesday, February 15, 2022. All required enrollment forms & immunization record must be completed in full and received prior to attending camp.

REGISTRATION FORMS

All forms required for registration can be downloaded on our website, www.sheboygancountymca.org/camp-y-koda or picked up at a YMCA Branch. Online registration for camps is available.

HOW TO REGISTER

Before starting your registration, please have ALL immunization, medical and health history information ready before starting the registration process. Please see our checklist on page 11. **Please pick one option below:**

- **ONLINE** – Visit our website at www.sheboygancountymca.org/camp-y-koda and create an account. All forms & immunization information are required to complete your child's registration online and to reserve their spot. **Please note:** In order to receive the member rate you must have an active family or youth membership at the time of program registration and participation.
- **IN PERSON** – At YMCA Camp Y-Koda, Sheboygan YMCA or Sheboygan Falls YMCA.
- **EMAIL OR MAIL** – All Forms & Immunization Record can be sent to one of our contacts listed. **Please note:** Payment is required to reserve your child's spot and forms will not be entered until we have the required information & payment.

PLEASE READ: There are limited number of spaces per camp. We HIGHLY RECOMMEND that you register online and register for all your weeks at once to guarantee a spot for your child. Registrations are processed in the order received.

Non-Online Registration methods are entered Monday-Friday and will not be entered until payment & missing information is received. Confirmation of your child's enrollment will be made via email through our online registration platform. If you do not receive a confirmation email, please contact Camp Y-Koda.

PAYMENT METHODS

- **ONLINE REGISTRATION:** Credit Card & E-Check will only be accepted.
- **IN-PERSON REGISTRATION:** Cash, Check, Credit or Debit are only accepted.

You can pay for each week of camp by the specified payment plan and the deadlines as stated in your Parent Handbook.

PLEASE READ: Occasionally, camp scheduling, field trips, and content are subject to change due to ratios, inclement weather, and unforeseen events or circumstances. We will do our best to notify parents when these changes occur.

- No refunds on cancellations received after May 1, 2022.

FRIEND REQUEST

If your child plans to attend camp with a friend or group of friends, you may request they be placed with the same counselor by filling in the "Friend Request" section on the registration form.

- In order to be in the same group, children must be in the same age category and attend the same camp.

Check-out page 2 to find ways to save on your child's camp fees!

PLEASE READ: If registering in-person, all the above steps are required to reserve your child's spot in the desired camp.

Children will be taken off rosters if:

- All required paperwork is not on file at least 10 days prior to the start of your child's first day of camp. This is a State Licensing Mandate and we cannot allow a child to attend without completed paperwork.
- There is an outstanding balance on any camp. The payment schedule is listed on page 10.

The camp was founded in 1969 by the Sheboygan County YMCA and has been offering summer camp experiences ever since. Camp Y-Koda features a beautiful stretch of the Sheboygan River for canoeing, kayaking, tubing and nature studies. The property has a low and high ropes course complete with a zip line and 40-foot climbing wall.

YMCA Camp Y-Koda also features a swimming pool, 4-acre lake, bb gun and archery range, basketball and volleyball courts, playground, soccer field, arts and crafts center and camp store, and a huge slip and slide. There are two lodges at camp, Lohmann Lodge and Johnsonville Lodge. They serve as headquarter areas during inclement weather, our cafeteria and lodging for resident camps and other indoor programming. Camp has four campsites which include cabins, a picnic and campfire area. In addition, Camp has a new pavilion area named the Denison Pavilion, which houses our Pee Wee campers and is a site for snack and camp activities.

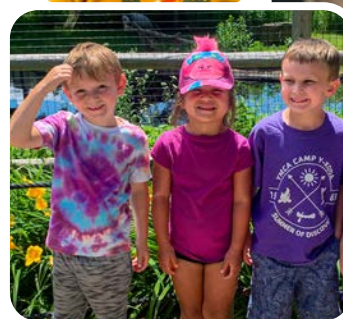

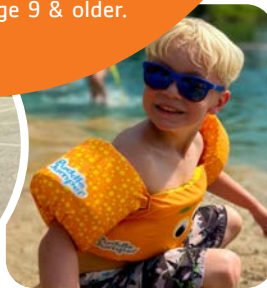


DAY CAMP

Activities

As part of the Maywood schedule, campers visit the Sheboygan Quarry Park once during the week for swimming and playing on the inflatable water structures. All campers must sign a quarry waiver form provided by the aquatic park. These waivers will be collected in the beginning of each week as needed or prior to your campers arrival. Campers are under the supervision of our counselors and the park staff. It is the Quarry Park's policy that all individuals at the park must wear a life jacket provided by the quarry, including adults. All swimming & aquatics are lifeguarded by our American Red Cross trained lifeguarding staff.

In addition to the Quarry, as part of the schedule groups may be assigned to have the opportunity to partake in activities in the Pigeon River and Maywood's smaller ponds. These are a no swim area and campers will partake in using tubes & canoes or go on a river walk and river play. All water supervision in the smaller ponds & river are lifeguarded by certified staff. All Campers registered for a Maywood Camp is required to complete the Sheboygan Quarry Park Waiver Form.
