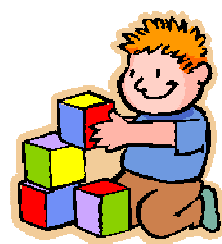

Program Description

Learning doesn't need to take a vacation this summer! Keep your brain at the top of its game by enrolling in summer school! We have classes that will keep your skills sharp for your next grade, explore new learning, and stimulate imagination and creativity. Join us for three fun-filled weeks in June and August of high-interest, motivating classes designed for students who will be entering kindergarten through fifth grade. Classes blend skills maintenance and enrichment activities with core subject curriculum.

Classes meet June 11th through June 29th Monday through Friday. Classes will provide students with various learning opportunities and will meet from 8:00 a.m-12:00 p.m. Breakfast will be served each morning for students wishing to have the items.

June Course Descriptions

All Aboard

An exciting class that combines cooperation and teamwork while participating in a variety of physical activities! We will enjoy cooperative games and motor-skill development activities including catching and throwing.

Amazing Art

During this class your child will use a variety of art mediums to create amazing masterpieces based on the Eric Carle stories. They will also learn how the artist accomplished such techniques. Be prepared to be amazed!

American Girls- Bring History to Life

Using the American Girl doll series you will learn about life in America from 1764-1974. We will read and journal each day as well as cook and make crafts from each of the time periods.

Animal Genius

From the soft and cuddly to the creepy and untamed, join the exploration of animal life and ecology. Through hands-on activities, we'll learn about the habitats of animals, their life cycles, their place in a food chain and their daily way of life. We'll enjoy books, art projects, games, movies and outdoor exploration.

Backpacking through Europe

Prepare to "travel" to England, France, Italy and Germany as you board the SFES World Airlines. You will learn about different languages, famous places, literature, sports, clothing, food and currency. Bon Voyage!

Become Tech Savvy with the Click of a Class

Techies unite to create multimedia projects! Improve your presentation and research skills. Come learn new computer programs and create brochures, digital story-books, videos and much more. We will cover Microsoft Word, Publisher and PowerPoint, as well as blogging, internet safety and keyboarding.

Camp Falcon

Camp Write Away

Come Write Away with us! We will spend time exploring fiction, nonfiction, poetry, comics and partner stories. We will create writer's journals. Students will learn author's styles and research nonfiction topics. Students will create comics, make a class story, work on keyboarding skills and even have a poetry celebration. The Camp Write Away will encourage cooperation, creative thinking and allow your child to have fun writing! Come, Write Away with us this summer.

Creating and Playing Through Math

Kids, “On your mark, get set, GO…” Join us for fun cooking and games! We will be using math to make recipes and to play games. Some of the fun games will include bowling, track and field and horseshoes. We challenge you to stay dry on our “wet and wild” day. Recipes that we will create include face paint, Kool-Aid finger paint and different kinds of food.

Creative Thinkers

Hands-on and creative class. Children will have the opportunity to review, enrich and enhance their knowledge, skills and strategies. Emphasis will be on literacy and math activities.

Dance, Dance, Dance

Are you ready to dance, move and have fun? If yes this is the class for you! You will learn dance moves and experience a variety of music. Once you find the beat, you won't stop moving your feet!

Educational Internet/SMARTBOARDS

Students will be introduced to and have time to play with a variety of safe, fun and educational websites geared towards their age level. Reading, spelling, math, science and social studies sites will be explored to help students apply their knowledge in a fun way!

Environmental Discovery

Planting, observing, and learning more about our world are the focus of this class. Comfortable outdoor clothing should be worn!

Fitness Follies

Explore the adventures of playing highly active fun games every day! Each class will set fitness goals and work on those goals with a team. You will have loads of fun.

For Dog Lovers Only

Looking for something fun to do during the “dog days” of summer? Exploring all about the wonderful world of dogs through art and reading experiences will be the emphasis of this class. Visits from some canine companions will prove how dogs enrich our lives.

Fun and Games for Everyone at all Levels

Come join us in an action-packed class that integrates physical education with recreation and healthy habits. We will have cup stacking tournaments, juggling, kickball games, soccer and more fitness activities.

Fun in the Arts

Do you love acting, singing, drawing or painting? Come join us as we produce our own musical. Try your hand at painting a set, singing a musical chorus, or acting out a great role. There is something for everyone. Please join us!

Instrument Making

Students in the class will make a few different musical instruments, including the drum and learn the history of each instrument they build.

The Magic of Cooking and Fitness

This class will focus on cooking and nutrition/fitness. Students will learn about the food guide pyramid, healthy food choices, and the importance of being active. They will participate in fitness activities daily and log their movement. Students will cook and learn to make healthy and delicious recipes. At the end of the session, students will bring home an activity log as well as a recipe book.

Math Mania

This program is designed for the students to build upon their skills. It is structured around the use of engaging and real-life problem solving strategies and cooperative learning. An interactive learning environment will be created using math manipulatives, more complex math games and a variety of other innovative activities.

On Stage

Come explore and develop your imagination! Step into someone else's shoes for a while. Learning and practice acting skills, practice creative problem solving and self-expression. Let's put on a play!

Photography for Kids

Students will learn the basics of camera use and different types of photography, including portrait, nature and still life and some editing methods.

Reading, Writing and Rocking

Students will explore how different types of music create different moods in stories, poetry and song. Students will read and listen to various genres of reading and music, then have the opportunity to use their imagination in creative writing projects.

Reader's Theater

Come and join us in "theater for the imagination!" In Reader's Theater children will have the opportunity to participate in the same well known folk and fairy tales by reading parts of scripts. No props or memorization will be used, but rather verbal expression and imagination. We will be reading scripts, choosing parts, practicing and performing our short plays! 5...4...3...2...1... Action!!!

Relax and Read

Is your life just too busy to sit down and read? Do you find that a whole week flies by and your child has not read for enjoyment? The best way to be a better reader is to practice! This course is designed to allow your child to develop an enjoyment of personal reading. Different genres will be explored with an emphasis on finding a good book and getting into it.

Science Magic

This hands-on science class will take you on a Magical Journey through space, time, the human body and much more. In this course students will sharpen their problem solving skills and learn experimental design. The magic is in understanding how science really works! Get ready for a wild ride!

Sign Language

This course will give students an introduction to basic sign language (the fourth most commonly used language in the United States). The focus of this course will be everyday communication. Students will learn the ASL alphabet and to finger spell using this knowledge. They will also learn greetings and everyday vocabulary. Music and games will also be incorporated into the sessions.

Story Time, Snacks and Surprises!

Come read, write and dine with us this summer! Your child will be introduced to cooking and nutrition through healthy, kid-friendly recipes. Throughout the session students will make their very own cookbook of recipes, participate in properly measuring ingredients and acquire new skills. They will be actively engaged through hands-on learning focused upon strengthening math and communication arts skills. Read, mix, measure and eat your way to the best summer ever!

Storybook Theater

Lights, camera, action! Come join the fun as we discover how story book characters come to life. Fairytales, fables, favorite stories and more. We will explore the world as students read, write, act out and design costumes and props for their favorite stories. Grab your director's cap as you explore the many pages of Storybook Theater.

Summer Science Exploration

Explore backyard weather, wildlife (birds, insects...) and more through observations, mini-hikes and experiments. Discover how to be observant to all that is around you. Hands on and interactive fun!

Where in the Word

Word play uses a variety of fun vocabulary building games such as Scrabble, Jr. and Boggle to help students increase their language arts skills.

Fun With Sounds!!

This class is intended for Kindergarten and First grade students who want to have fun while improving letter-sound awareness, speech sounds as well as listening skills within a group environment. This class will include songs, crafts, and will incorporate SMART board technology. Fun With Sounds will be taught by Speech/Language Pathologists.

August Course Descriptions

Early Childhood – Jump Start

The program will consist of large and small group activities, circle time, purposeful play time, and outside activities. Readiness skills are incorporated into the curriculum highlighting on cognitive, emotional, social and physical development. Snacks will be provided to the children. **Held at the Sheboygan Falls Middle School.**

4 Year Old Kindergarten – Jump Start

We offer a jump start to the 4K program beginning in fall. The main focus will be familiarizing the students with the building and some of the routines of a typical day in 4K. Children will also have the chance to meet some of the 4K staff and begin interacting with some of their peers. **Held at the Sheboygan Falls Middle School.**

5 Year Old Kindergarten – Jump Start

The Kindergarten readiness class will emphasize group and individual kindergarten readiness skill activities and social interaction.

1st grade – Jump Start

The 1st grade readiness class will be familiarizing the students with their rooms and some of the routines of a typical day as a 1st grader with a desk. Children will also have the chance to meet with some of the 1st grade teachers and peers.

Read Around Town

Have you ever wondered how the pins get set back up at the bowling alley? Or wondered what happens in the kitchen after you put in your order? How do the Police and the Fire Departments use reading and writing in their jobs? These and many other questions you might have about how businesses work will be answered in this summer school class, “Read Around Town”. We will travel to six different places in Sheboygan Falls and learn how important reading and writing are in the daily operations of these places. We will also have the opportunity to do additional reading and writing about some of the different occupations we will see. It is a fun, exciting way to learn the importance of reading and writing in our daily lives.

Summer RLAP

We feel that just before school starts is the perfect time for us to work with students to prepare them for the upcoming school year. This “jump start” to the school year will give students an opportunity to get back in the learning mode. If you are not able to make the entire session, we still encourage you to send your child, even part of the time will be beneficial.
