Dear Sheboygan County Businesses, Non-Profits, Schools, Community Members,



#### **EVENT LOCATION:**

#### **SCARECROW CONTEST RULES FOR ENTRY:**

- Please read the following information before completing your entry.
- Anyone can enter! Businesses, Non-Profits, Kids, Families, Schools, Organizations, Clubs etc.

#### SCARECROW MATERIALS AND DESIGN:

Scarecrows must be durable and all ornamentation securely attached as they may be subjected to wind/rain/snow. No water absorbent materials may be used for stuffing. No perishable goods may be used in the construction or display. YMCA Camp Y-Koda and Christopher Farm and Gardens staff reserve the right to remove any scarecrow that does not hold up to natural elements.

- YMCA Camp Y-Koda and Christopher Farm and Gardens will supply metal posts in the ground for holding each scarecrow on set-up day. Post are approximately 6 feet tall.
- Maximum area 6 ft. x 6 ft.
- Maximum height of 8 feet
- Your exhibit may include more than one figure, but not more than three.
- Shredded paper & straw can be used as scarecrow packing material. Please place these items in plastic bags before stuffing your scarecrow.
- Participants are responsible for supplying all materials for their scarecrow, except the post. Including materials to secure scarecrow to post.
- Participants are responsible for assisting Christopher Farm and Gardens staff as needed with the erection of their scarecrow(s).
- Scarecrow design and type are completely up to the participants. Be creative!
- Scarecrow designs must be family friendly.

#### **SET-UP DATES:**

Scarecrows will be set up at Christopher Farm & Gardens on Thursday, October 6, 2022 or Friday, October 7, 2022. Arrangements will be made with scarecrow exhibitors for appointments for set-up times. Set up and event is a rain or shine. Please plan accordingly.



#### SET-UP OF SCARECROWS:

- Participants may bring their scarecrow fully assembled or assemble on-site during their scheduled setup day at Christopher Farms and Gardens.
- Set-up details will be emailed out by Monday, September 26, 2022.
- Participants should bring a method for attaching the scarecrow to the post, such as wire orrope.
- Participants are responsible for clean-up around their post after constructing their scarecrow.
- Scarecrows must be completed and displayed by 5:00pm on Friday, October 7, 2022.

#### JUDGING:

Scarecrow Festival attendees will judge the scarecrows during their scarecrow tour. Each person will vote for the best scarecrow in each of the categories: business, non-profit, kid/family, & school groups. Winners of the contest will be announced the week following the event!

#### RESTRICTIONS:

All scarecrow entries are subject to limitations of space availability as well as the standards of display as established by YMCA Camp Y-Koda and Christopher Farm and Garden staff and committee. YMCA Camp Y-Koda and Christopher Farm and Garden reserves the right to deny entry privileges of displays considered offensive. Scarecrows must be in good taste and not reflect controversial /social/or political situations. Neither YMCA Camp Y-Koda nor Christopher Farm and Garden, their board of directors, committee, nor employees will be held responsible for any injury or damage associated with the 2022 Scarecrow Festival. It is understood YMCA Camp Y-Koda and Christopher Farm and Gardens board members, committee members and employees may use photographs, videos of, stories about, and the actual scarecrow entries themselves and entrant names for publicity and promotion of the event.

#### **PICK-UP AFTER EVENT:**

Specific arrangements will be made for scarecrow pick up to occur at assigned times on Monday, October 10, 2022 or Tuesday, October 11, 2022.

\*\*Entries not picked up by their owners after October 12, 2022 will become part of the Christopher Farm and Gardens fall decorations and the property of the Christopher Farm and Gardens to be disposed of as they wish.
